#### **Eligibility:**

Aged 18 years or over and a British citizen, a Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of a European Union country AND any of the below apply:

- On the electoral register for Queen Camel.
- Live within the Parish of Queen Camel, or within three miles of it for 12+months,
- Owner or tenant of land within the Parish of Queen Camel for 12+months,
- Had your only or main place of work in the Parish of Queen Camel for 12+months,
